# Race Across Michigan

#### March 18, Pure Michigan

On Saturday, March 18, a caravan of MRunners left Ann Arbor before the crack of dawn. Their goal: run 184 miles from Detroit to South Haven in one epic relay known as the "Race Across Michigan." One of MRun's proudest traditions, the Race Across Michigan (RAM) is both an exhaustive 24-hour race and the culminations of months of fundraising and planning on behalf of the entire club. This year, however, was something truly special. Under the leadership of RAM Coordinators Connor Foley and Matthew LeDuc, this year's race finally broke the "\$20,000 raised" barrier, donating a record sum to the Washtenaw County Special Olympics. Foley and LeDuc, celebrating their achievement, promptly went for a 4am swim in Lake Michigan.
